About this form and your rights Schools are required by federal and state law to identify students living in temporary housing and ensure they can enroll, attend, and succeed in school. The McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, together with New York State Education Law Section §3209, protects students and families who no longer have a permanent, stable place to live; families who have lost housing; are staying with others temporarily; or are living somewhere that was never meant to be a home. Eligible students have the right to: ✓ Stay in the school they attended when last permanently housed (called the school of origin), for as long as they are in temporary housing. ✓ Immediately enroll in the local school where they are temporarily staying (the school of current location). ✓ Enroll and start school right away, even without a birth certificate, proof of residency, immunization records, or school records. ✓ Receive free transportation to and from the school of attendance, as well as after-school activities (If within 50 miles). ✓ Receive free school meals without income paperwork as well as access to other school services including McKinney-Vento Grant resources, if available. This information is confidential and will be shared only with school staff who have a legitimate educational need to support student access to McKinney-Vento rights and services. Providing this information is voluntary and will be used only to determine eligibility for services under the McKinney-Vento Act and NYS Education Law §3209. Providing it will not affect your immigration status or your eligibility for enrollment or other services.
